Depending upon the type of the course

- Teacher shows how to solve these examples for concrete applications of the concept
- OR Show books, articles, videos with the real examples of the concept explained




GIVE THEM EXERCISES TO DO



- 1. Teacher should show the exercises on their screen and ask all students to workout all the exercises on paper (show few exercises at a time). And keep a timer between 1min to 5min to complete, depending on the questions.
- 2. Once students have solved some of the exercises, teacher should pick on each child in a circle to have turns to answer the questions.
- 3. If students are more than questions solved, then they can be asked in the next round.
- 4. Make sure not to give chance to same student even though they raise hanAd and do not allow students to shout out answers.
- 5. Some kids are very shy to answer or participate in class, so make sure all get equal chances always and everyone is involved in every class.



EASY TO REMEMBER LEARNING STRATEGIES



Share the tools, tips, and techniques to remember better.



HOMEWORK TIME



Assign a task for students to work independently, practice the learnings and develop self-discipline.



STUDENT FEEDBACK



The teacher should complete an individual student feedback sheet at the end of every lesson. This helps the parents to know the progression of their children.

O THINGS TO REMEMBER









- 1. Presentation slides should have less descriptive text with good quality images and your oral detailed explanation will make it better understandable for the students.
- 2. Voice modulation is very important when teaching to keep the children attentive, change your tonality in a few places especially when you are explaining the concepts.
- 3. The parent will also complete a feedback form about the teacher.
